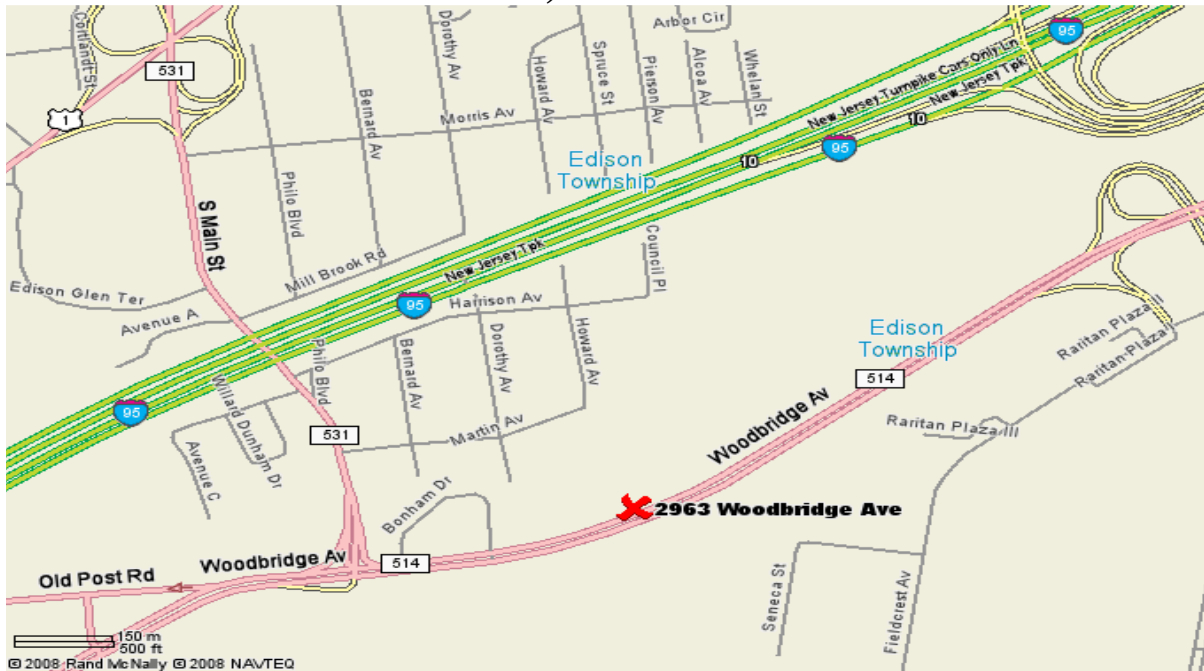


Edison Senior Center

Directions:

From NJ Turnpike (North or South): Exit at Interchange 10 (Edison/Metuchen). Stay to the RIGHT tollbooths. As you pass through the tollbooth, keep to the RIGHT and follow the ROUTE 514 WEST/HIGHLAND PARK/RARITAN CENTER ramp. Follow ROUTE 514 West past the NY Times Plant. Immediately beyond the NY Times Plant, prepare to make a right turn into the upper parking lot. The Driveway is immediately beyond the NY Times Access Road traffic light and railroad crossing. Should you miss this turn, proceed to the South Main St. traffic light, turn right, travel one block and turn right onto Martin Ave. Follow Martin Ave. for one long block to Yelencsics Park and the Edison Senior Citizen Center.

From Garden State Parkway and Points North: Travel South on the Garden State Parkway and exit at EXIT 130 to Route 1 South. Take Route 1 South to the BONHAMTOWN exit (The exit is just beyond the I-287 interchange and overpass). Follow South Main St. over Route 1, past the Raritan Valley Bus Company Garage and continue under the NJ Turnpike overpass. Turn left onto MARTIN Ave. Follow Martin Ave. for one long block to Yelencsics Park and the Edison Senior Citizen Center.

From Garden State Parkway and Points South: As you travel North on the Garden State Parkway stay in the RIGHT-HAND Lanes as you drive over the Driscoll Bridge. Follow the signs for I-287 North/NJ Route 440 North. Stay in the LEFT-Hand lanes until you are on Route 440/I-287 and prepare to exit at the Route 514 & NJ Turnpike ramp. As you pass under I-287, BEAR LEFT at the ROUTE 514 WEST/HIGHLAND PARK/RARITAN CENTER ramp. Follow ROUTE 514 West past the NY Times Plant. Immediately beyond the NY Times Plant, prepare to make a right turn into the upper parking lot. The Driveway is immediately beyond the NY Times Access Road traffic light and railroad crossing. Should you miss this turn, proceed to the South Main St. traffic light, turn right, travel one block and turn right onto Martin Ave. Follow Martin Ave. for one long block to Yelencsics Park and the Edison Senior Citizen Center.
